POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

You will be assigned one or more swim classes to teach but may be called upon to teach any level of swim lessons, from preschool through adult. You will teach in accordance with the YMCA Swim Lesson Program Curriculum. Critical to your success as an Instructor and the Y's continued reputation as a provider of highest quality swim instruction, is the relationship that you build with your students and their parents. This will be accomplished through positive and regular communication with students and parents relative to progress, concerns, questions and suggestions while maintaining a safe and friendly aquatic learning environment.

PRIMARY QUALIFICATIONS

Skills: You must have knowledge of and ability to demonstrate and teach proper swim strokes and skills. Previous teaching experience not required. You must be able to effectively communicate to individuals and small groups in a noisy environment. You must possess the ability to recognize individual differences and adjust swim lessons accordingly.

Competencies: Most important is the ability to build positive relationships and self-confidence as an Instructor. Other critical competencies include patience, problem solving creativity, motivational skills and the ability to work independently. You must exhibit the Y core values of respect, responsibility, honesty and caring.

Certifications: CPR for the Professional Rescuer w/AED and First aid is required. YMCA Swim Lesson Program certification preferred but not required. American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor certification preferred but not required.

Physical Requirements: You must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds, routinely demonstrate proper swimming and CPR techniques and tolerate chlorine and temperatures up to 90 degrees with high humidity.

Age: Minimum 15 years
