POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

Our gymnastics program includes classes ranging from Parent/Tot through High School Competitive Team. Whether the reason for the gymnast's participation is recreation, exercise or competitive sport, your most important role as an Instructor or Coach is youth development. Building gymnastic skills is your means to that end. You will teach in accordance with the National YMCA Progressive Gymnastics' Program, which focuses on positive feedback and mental attitude. Relationship building with gymnasts and their parents and ensuring a safe and positive environment are critical to our program and your success as an Instructor/Coach.

PRIMARY QUALIFICATIONS

Skills: Knowledge of gymnastics skills and rules and safety awareness are required. Personal experience as a gymnast, background in Y sports philosophy and experience teaching at individual or group level are beneficial. You must possess the ability to recognize individual differences and adjust lessons accordingly.

Competencies: You must be sensitive to the needs of individuals and have the ability to build rapport with participants and parents. Other critical competencies include patience, problem solving creativity, motivational skills and a spirit of good sportsmanship. You must exhibit the Y core values of respect, responsibility, honesty and caring.

Certifications: Community CPR w/AED and First Aid is a position prerequisite but you are allowed 90 days post hire to achieve.
