STEVENS POINT AREA YMCA AMERICAN RED CROSS FIRST AID/CPR/AED COURSE

COURSE PURPOSE

The purpose of the First Aid/CPR/AED course is to teach participants the knowledge and skills necessary to provide care for breathing and choking emergencies, and perform CPR for victim of cardiac arrest.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

A digital copy of the American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED Manual and pocket mask is included for each participant. Certifications will be issued upon successful completion of the course and multiple-choice exam.

COURSE FORMAT

In-Person courses are 5.5 hours in length and will be led by an instructor throughout the entire course.



Blended Learning courses will include 2.5 hours of online course work followed by a 3 - 4 hour instructor led session. The online portion must be complete and a printed proof of completion must be provided to the instructor at the start of the classroom portion of the course.
